After many hours of training and the occasional sacrifice that you have to make as an athlete, I made it through the candidate group into the junior C squad and am now a member of the Swiss-Ski elite B squad. Thanks to my apprenticeship as a commercial employee, which I completed parallel to my sport, I have also learned how to deal with double workloads. In my first years at the elite level, I was able to place in the top 10 several times in the IBU Cup and also celebrate a podium finish. I have already competed in various individual and relay races in the World Cup. I successfully completed my basic training as a customs and border security specialist in June 2025, and have decided to specialise in the persons domain.
